INSTITUTIONAL CODE OF CONDUCT

For Students

- 1. The students must be regular to the college and should actively take part in all the activities of the college.
- 2. Students are strictly instructed to give Bio–metric attendance during check in and check out of the campus.
- 3. The day starts with assembly with agenda of prayer, news reading, and thought for the day, followed by Birthday wishes.
- 4. The students must wear uniform dress and id-card within the college campus.
- 5. Students are required to maintain regular attendance to be eligible for appearing in the University Examination. A student-teacher must have 80% of attendance in Theory classes and 90% attendance in Practicum classes in each course for appearing the Semester Examinations.
- 6. Student-Teachers are required to check the Notice Board (both Offline & Online) regularly for important announcements.
- 7. Student-Teachers are not allowed to loiter or stand in the Corridors of the College during class hours.
- 8. Using of mobile inside the classroom is strictly prohibited. However, during emergency, they may use with the permission of the staff.
- 9. Disciplinary rules regarding punctuality, regularity, respect for teachers, concern for the welfare of the college is to be carefully maintained.
- 10.Students suffering from health issues need to take permission for leave and to produce medical certificate.

- 14.No posters are to be pasted or fixed with cello-tape anywhere on the College Building/walls. Any writing, scribbling on the walls will attract disciplinary measures against the student-teachers.
- 15.Ragging in any conduct by a student, as an individual or group of them whether by words spoken or written, or by an act, which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling the fresher or any other student with rudeness will be treated as ragging and will be entitled for disciplinary action.
- 16.Student-Teachers are forbidden from inviting friends from other institutions and outsiders to the College.
- 17.Smoking, drinking alcoholic beverages and intoxicating drinks by the studentteacher within the college campus are strictly prohibited.
- 18. There will be a student council, constituted for the welfare and development of the college and unity and security of all students for a period of one year headed by the Principal as President for the council and elected representatives from the students of the college.
- 19.Student-Teachers are expected to treat the members of the staff both teaching and non-teaching with courtesy both in and outside the College. Students shall not, by their act or conduct, cause damage to the reputation of the institution.
- 20.Students desirous of leaving station will be required to apply for leave
- 21.Students are informed to submit their tutorial, assignments or any other projects assigned within the time stipulated.
